

What's Included*



- *Please note diagrams show images of the 110 oz fountain, but the manual applies to both the 54 oz and the 110 oz fountains.
- **The pump, pump housing, and foam filter come pre-assembled and installed at the bottom of the bowl. The pump includes a USB-A cord. USB adaptor not included.

How it Works

The Premier Pet® Fountains provide fresh, filtered water and feature a water level window so that you can easily see when the water needs to be refilled. The submersible pump is customizable with adjustable flow control and recirculates the water, passing it through a Dual-Filter System. The foam filter removes dirt and hair, and the activated carbon filter removes bad tastes and odors. The continuously moving water prevents bacteria growth, keeping the fountain cleaner than a standard water bowl. The BPA-free plastic design comes apart for easy cleaning and is top-shelf dishwasher safe (excluding the pump).


Setup Instructions

 Press down on the pump assembly to secure it to the bottom of the bowl.

The pump assembly should be within the tabbed area at the bottom of the bowl, with the arrow on the pump housing pointing toward the front.






 Thoroughly rinse the carbon filter and slide it into the slot at the back of the bowl.

The filter can go in any direction with either the white or black side facing out.



4. Place the fountain in the desired location. Fill the bowl with water up to the MAX fill line. Attach the tray to the bowl with the hole in the tray facing the back of the bowl. Push down on the tray to ensure it is firmly in place.

NOTE: Never let the water level drop below the MIN fill line or your pump might fail.




 Make sure the power cord and your hands are completely dry. Connect the power cord to a USB adaptor (not included) and then plug it into a standard electrical wall outlet.




Cleaning & Maintenance

NOTE: Clean the fountain every 2-4 weeks as needed. Replace the carbon filter every 2-4 weeks and replace the foam filter every 1-2 months.


- 1. Unplug the fountain.
- 2. Pick up the fountain by the bowl and take it to the sink.
- 3. Remove the tray and discard the carbon filter.
- 4. Remove the pump housing, foam filter, and pump from the bowl.
- 5. Remove the pump from the pump housing.
- Disassemble and clean the pump, referring to the following steps:
 NOTE: It is important to fully disassemble and clean your pump every 2-4 weeks minimum or more often if needed
- Remove the pump faceplate by using your finger to pull up on the small tab.



 Remove the stator with flowcontrol knob by pulling up on the small lip. Do not throw this or any other part of the pump away.




 Use a fingernail to pull out the impeller, which is held in place magnetically. Rinse all of the pump parts before reassembling.



inserting the impeller. Then, replace the stator and faceplate. Make sure the flow control knob on the stator is in the correct position for your desired flow rate. **NOTE:** If the flow is too strong or spraying any water while it is running, try adjusting the flow to a

lower setting.



7. Wash all of the other parts with warm water and soap or place them in the top rack of the dishwasher. If needed, remove any hard water buildup using a solution of 80% water and 20% white vinegar.


NOTE: Do not place the pump or USB adaptor in the dishwasher.

- 8. Reassemble the pet fountain:
- a. Insert the pump into the pump housing. Push it all the way in.



 Place the foam filter around the pump inside the pump housing with the filter wrapped around the blue faceplate on the pump.

NOTE: The foam filter may be a tight fit inside the pump housing, but that is normal and will help keep the pump in place.



 c. Complete the assembly, referring to steps 1 through 5 of the Setup Instructions.
